Thank you for sending me a copy of your tentative texts of the tablets found at Pylos in 1955. Until such time as they appear in published form, this will be a very useful guide.

I am a little surprised to see that Fr 1184 appears second in the list. Was this tablet really found in 1955?

I have recently been interesting myself in tablet Ae 134, and have been comparing the photograph published by Ventris in Archaeology 1954 with your own facsimile and text in The Pylos Tablets 1955. I have found it difficult to recognise the last syllable of qe-to-ro-po-pi as a pi in your system. Do you really think that this final syllable is pi, or did you import the reading from the other Pylos text in which qe-to-ro-po-pi does occur?
