Dear Mr. Link:

I appreciate greatly your letter of April 14 informing me of possibilities with your company and suggesting a procedure for me.

My present position with the University is excellent and I am considered indisponible on account of my knowledge of Coastal Plain stratigraphy and local geology. However, facilities are not satisfactory and possibilities of advancement are small. Hence I am probably going to make a change. However, at present I am not in a position to make a formal application with your company. As soon as conditions have clarified sufficiently, I shall follow your suggestions.
