Dear Dr. Bennett,

Many thanks for your letter and for the copy of your gallant effort to produce a Consolidated Index of the Sigla in Studies (SMID). It is very good of you to offer it for publication in Studies V; unfortunately I am not sure whether it can be included this year, as only a few days ago I returned the 'proofs' of the stencils (and the issue is already sorely belated). However, I write to Chadwick at once to see if it can still be managed. With that in mind I have made a list of all the new names in No. V — these number as many as 68! — and for your interest I have written them on the back of this sheet.

The alphabetical order here (I hadn't time to arrange otherwise as yet) shows that of the names (with the exception of COP before instead of after COOK, perperam).

When I took over the editing last year I constructed a similar list for my own convenience in allotting new sigla, and this brought to my notice ^{existing} such doublets as HG = both H. Gein + H. Grigorie and SM = both Scripta Nova and S. Maun (the latter doesn't matter much, since one is italicised). I fear that ad hoc creations were made year by year without much attention to the past; nor has much attempt been made to make a siglum internally significant. I made a taboo list too (perhaps add IRH and ICS to your list! They aren't bad [to be italicised] and they may be needed some day!).

I'll let you know when I hear more. (I also have a few conjecturae to recent numbers of Notulae, if these are of use).
