Dear Dr. Lagaaij:

Thank you very much for your prompt reply to my letter. I regret that you are not going to be at Bordeaux. It would have been very nice to get together again and to discuss Bryozoa or other fossils.

My preliminary plans for this trip are to leave Houston, Wednesday, August 15, at 12:45 p.m. by KLM, to arrive at Amsterdam, Thursday, August 16, at 7:10 a.m., and to stay for one day or more in Amsterdam. Then, I have to be at Mulhouse, Alsace, on Sunday, August 19, because the next day early in the morning the field trip no. 2 (Mulhouse-Mayence-Belgique-Ile du France) starts.
