FIGHTER COMMAND HAS "WINGS FOR VICTORY" WEEK PLAN  
PILOT WHO DELIVERED STAMP-COVERED BOMB

To help the R.A.F. Fighter Command's own "Wings for Victory" week pilots of a Typhoon fighter-bomber squadron in South-East England are buying savings stamps to stick on one of their own 250-lb. bombs. Ground crews and other personnel on the station are also to be invited to contribute stamps to the bomb, and personal delivery by one of the squadron's pilots is guaranteed.

The squadron is an auxiliary unit with a notable record of successful day and night attacks on the enemy's land and sea communications in occupied territory.

Fighter Command's "Wings for Victory" week opens next Friday with a "target" figure of £150,000, and among the many "savings-raising schemes" which have been planned is a competition at Command Headquarters for which the tickets will be savings stamps, certificates and bonds. The prizes, most of which have been offered by officers, airmen, and W.A.A.F. on the headquarters staff, include two front-row stalls at a London theatre, a champagne dinner at a well-known London restaurant, a case of make-up material, model hats, perfume and a bottle of whiskey.
