INDIA JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE NO:170

The following Joint War Communique from India was received in London today :

Yesterday morning, June 30, R.A.F. bombers with fighter escort attacked two groups of buildings in which Japanese troops are quartered near Myohaung, about thirty-five miles north-east of Akyab. The first groups of buildings was demolished and hits were observed on the second. Other objectives in the vicinity were then machine-gunned.

Beaufighters on offensive patrol along the Irrawaddy made a number of attacks on river craft and damaged twenty-five of them. On June 29 fighter patrols damaged a number of sampans and other craft south of Akyab.

From these operations one of our aircraft is missing.
