JU.88 DOWN IN TWO SECONDS

A two-seconds burst of fire from a Beaufighter sent a Ju.88 crashing in flames near its base last night. The Beaufighter was on intruder patrol over the Low Countries when the pilot saw the Ju.88 and attacked with all his guns from astern.

"There were strikes all over the port side", he said, "and the Hun peeled off to port. Fire was spreading as he went down to crash in flames."

The airfield at Poix was bombed again last night by Whirlwinds of the squadron which at the weekend also attacked the airfield by night. This was followed by a daylight attack by Bostons.
