

THREE DESTROYED -- 17 DAMAGED

Two Mosquito pilots -- an American and a Canadian -- who fly in a R.C.A.F. squadron of Air Defence of Great Britain made attacks on several different types of German aircraft over France and Germany yesterday.

They destroyed three -- a Ju.34, a Ju.52 and a Diplane -- in the air, and left 17 others burning or severely damaged on the ground.

Two of the enemy machines were destroyed in the air by Lt. J. Luna, of Helena, Montana; in addition, he left a Do.217, a He.111 and a Gotha glider a "flaming pyre on the ground", as well as damaging two more gliders and two Me.109s.

Flt.Lt. D. MacFadyen, of Toronto, destroyed the Biplane as it was about to land at Haguenau airfield.

"I attacked with machine-guns and cannons just as it was making its landing", he said. "Suddenly it made a ground loop and burst into flames.

"I then found eight more Gothas resting on the airfield which I shot up."
