The Newman Memorial Fund - founded in 1886 in memory of the late Mr. Edward Newman, R.N., who died while serving as Chief Engineer of H.M. Dockyard at Portsmouth - consists of a sum of about £400. The interest on this sum is employed annually in providing a prize, consisting of books, scientific instruments, etc., which is conferred on the Engineer Officer, R.N., who takes the first place at the examination in practical engineering held on the completion of his original course of specialising in engineering.

Lieut Stead, who was born in 1921, joined H.M.S. Duke of York on January 5, 1943. His home town is Stratford-on-Avon, Warwickshire.
