The charges of July 13.1937, which are in question are not duplicated. The charge: one grease job \$ 1.00, refers to a grease job made on June 28.37. at a mileage of 11500 approximately. The charge: one grease job, 5 quarts of oil, 10 gallons of gas \$ 4.95, refers to a grease job made on July 5.37. at a mileage of 12545. There is the previous expense account an entry under July 28.37. of 5 quarts of oil at \$ 1.25. The oil was changed at the same date as the grease job was made, for which I paid at the later date of July 5. You will note that on the previous expense account ending with June 28, there is no entry for greasing although during these 15 days a grease job obviously was necessary.

I am sorry to cause you the trouble of this inquiry, which could have been avoided by an explanation in my expenseaccount.
