Dear Henryk:

In acknowledging your letter to me dated 16 September 1969, I note that we have been called on to make endless changes in figures intended for your Treatise volume on oysters. This has been very bothersome, but we must share with you effort to avoid errors. If we have made them, it is too bad. Some changes requested (as for your Fig. 341-B) merely involved arrangement of individual items, not always with significant improvements. I do not like your proposed alteration of 341-B, partly because I can see no significant need and partly because a full-page width figure is more difficult to handle in page makeup than single column figures. We have made other changes asked for, but I have not yet approved reconstruction of 341-B.

We do not have Coquand, 1869, and considerable delay will be involved in obtaining this on interlibrary loan. Unhappily, this seems to be necessary, because we can not determine whether errors have been introduced in preparing the Treatise figures.
