INDIA JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE NO.121

The following communique from India was received in London today:-

Yesterday May 1, R.A.F. Blenheims bombed a Japanese troop position in the Myittha valley south of Kalamyo. Many hits were observed in the target area: Beaufighters machine gunned supply sampans, steamers and warehouses along the Irrawaddy and Chindwin rivers from Frone to Monywa.

On the Arakan coast Hurricanes severely damaged a steamer in Myebon harbour.

Last night Wellington bombers attacked objectives at Taungup. All bombs were seen to burst in the target area and several large fires were started. Other aircraft dropped bombs on the marshalling yards at Moulmein and on Akyab town.

From these operations one of our aircraft is missing.
