
Dear Dr. Stenzel,

I would appreciate very much your message about the safe arrival of the material.

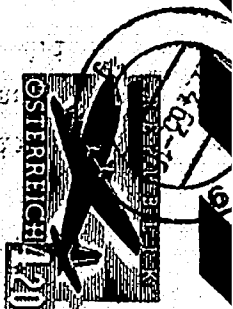
