Last fall you sent a small lot of Goniobasis to Mr. Goodrich. They were turned over to me and I have intended for some time to write to you concerning them. Recently I had an opportunity to determine what they were and am writing to give you the information and also to inquire whether you wish to have some specimens returned to you. The species is: Goniobasis catenaria cancellata Say. The locality given with the specimens is "Lithia Springs, Polk County, Florida". We have a lot from Lithia Springs, Hillborough County. Is it possible that we have the wrong county or are there two Lithia Springs? I would appreciate having any information you could give to help straighten this locality data.

Last summer Mr. Goodrich retired as curator in this division. He and Mrs. Goodrich went to Hendersonville, N.C. to spend the winter and to get away from the glacial conditions of a Michigan winter.
