

## MEMORANDUM

The first edition of the Biographical Directory of American Scholars is now in press. It will contain about 10,000 biographical sketches. It is planned that new editions shall be published at intervals of five years, if there is sufficient demand to defray the expense. The present edition is made possible by a grant given by the American Council of Learned Societies through the generosity of the Carnegie Corporation.

This is the first directory to be published in this field and it is hoped that it will help to maintain a common interest among those working in the various fields of the humanities and the social sciences. The costs of compiling and printing a work of this character and size are very large. It is presumably in the interest of those included that the book be widely circulated and that it appear regularly in new editions. It is consequently hoped that those who can afford the cost will order a copy of the book and that all will cooperate in forwarding its purchase by libraries and institutions.

An early return of the enclosed proof will save the expense of a second request and contribute toward prompt publication.
