Dr White has asked me to answer your letter of 16th June.

We have no specimens of Anacorax from the Danian here that can certainly be identified as A.pristodontus: all our Danian material seems to be A.falcatus, though we haven't a great deal of it. I can also find nothing in the literature to suggest that A.pristodontus goes up into the Danian.

If you have any sharks' teeth from the Texas Midway to spare we would be very glad to have some here, either as a gift or in exchange for something you may need.
