Dear Dr. Bennett,

Many thanks for yours of 31 Oct., which came today.

I quite understand your difficulties, & realize that most of the unrecorded fragments are small & difficult. I can however keep final pages open for any transcripts (not facsimiles, which are substantial texts, and do not seem to be recorded by Evans. If you send me your transcripts, I will check them with my materials, and withdraw any which I may succeed in identifying.

Junctions of fragments must probably wait for sub-

plementary publications: but I have already detected a few  
and included them in a section called "Critical Notes" at  
the end. There is about half a page blank here for such notes  
from yourself.

I should not in any case add to the Vocabulary, as it is made  
up for photolithography now. But if you have any new sign-groups  
they can be added in type with the new transcripts, with a cross-  
reference to the Vocabulary. Further occurrences also, of groups already  
in the Vocabulary, I think are well worth noting.

Heartly congratulations on your completion of the Paris copy for Prentiss
