A BILL TO BE ENTITLED TO ACT

PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE FALL LAKE GATHERING AND THE THANKSGIVING DINNER; NOW THEREFORE,

*Be it enacted by the Student Assembly of the University of Texas that:*

SECTION I: The Students' Association will allocate \$436.00 from the Multi-Cultural Funds for Students for Study Abroad (SSA), to assist in the costs of the Fall Lake Gathering and the Thanksgiving Dinner. The Gathering is the first major event of the year designed to bring together UT students and the exchange students on campus. The Thanksgiving Dinner is an SSA tradition to provide the exchange students an opportunity to get first hand experience as to the nature of this American tradition. Detailed budgets for both are attached.

SECTION II: Any remaining funds shall revert back to the Students' Association.

The committee feels that both projects, the Fall Lake Gathering and the Thanksgiving Dinner are worthy of receiving money. However, Students for Study Abroad has made very little fundraising efforts for either project and is hoping that the Students' Association will bankroll the whole thing. This organization has received funds from the Assembly in the past and the committee does not wish to set a precedent in which organizations make no attempts outside the Students' Association for money. Thus, the Appropriations committee recommends to allocate \$165 to fund the Fall Lake Gathering. This program will occur on September 26 and approximately 50 people are expected to attend. Anyone interested in international study abroad is welcome to attend, as are all international students. Then, it is our hope that the organization will search elsewhere for funds and return for additional funding only if necessary.
