My dear Dr. Ver Wiebe:

I am sending you a manuscript entitled "A New Zone in the Cook Mountain Formation, the Crassatella texalta Harris--Turritella cortesi Bowles Zone" for publication in the A.A.P.G. Bulletin. The paper is going to be given by title at the annual convention in Chicago this year. The paper contains three figures. Figure 1 is very large and is designed as a double page spread similar to figure 5 of Volume 23, No. 10, of the A.A.P.G. Bulletin. If my figure 1 is reduced by one-fourth it will fit on two pages in the same way as the above mentioned figure does. If necessary, it is possible to reduce my figure 1 by slightly more than one-fourth. However, the reduction should not approach one-fifth because that would probably blur the figure. Figure 2 is to be printed in the same size, fitting one page. Figure 3 is designed for one-half reduction. Figures 1 and 3 are being sent to you in a roll by separate mail; figure 2 accompanies the manuscript.
