We have been sending books from the Bureau Library to be catalogued, and have come across a snag and I thought you might be able to help us with it.

You remember the Linne: SYSTEMA NATURAE, 1789 set, v. 1, pts 1-7, v. 2, and v. 3. When the Catalog department checked, they found that v. 2 should have been v.2,pt.1; this volume, Vegetabile, ends with Polyandria Polygynia, The next volume (v.2,pt.2) should begin with Gidynamia cryptogamia and in the species list there are 6 pages which should be contained in the second part.

Do you remember whether this second volume was ever with the set? I looked on the holdings card but am never able to make sense out of the way things are entered there, but only one volume 2 is listed. Do you know from whom the set was obtained and when? Apparently somebody thought it was complete, but there should be 10 volumes in this set instead of 9.

Did you get the serials list I sent? It is rather awkward cut in two, but the two columns on each page are not consecutive--there are three pages on the board and the first columns are consecutive and the second columns consecutive, and if the pages are placed one atop the other you go mad trying to find your way around, which is why I cut them for you.
