LOSSES AT TOBRUK

The capture of Tobruk on June 21 involved the loss of elements of the following:-

United Kingdom;	201st Guards (Motor) Brigade. 32nd Army Tank Brigade.
South Africa;	H.Q. 2nd South African Division. 4th South African Infantry Brigade. 6th South African Infantry Brigade.
Indian;	11th Indian Infantry Brigade.

In these major formations forming the garrison of the fort were incorporated battalions of the Royal Tank Regiment and of the following Infantry Regiments:-

United Kingdom;	Coldstream Guards. Scots Guards (detachment only) The Worcestershire Regiment. The Queen's Own Cameron Highlanders.
South Africa;	Die Middellandse Regiment. Royal Durban Light Infantry. Transvaal Scottish. South African Police Battalions. Kaffrarian Rifles.
Indian;	Mahratta Light Infantry. Gurkha Rifles.

Apart from the Field Artillery and Anti-Tank Artillery and Royal Engineers included in the above formations there were in the garrison units of medium anti-aircraft and Coastal Defence, Survey and Searchlight Artillery and Royal Engineers, together with Signal, Service Corps and Medical Ordnance, Pay, Provost, Pioneer and Postal units, most of which were United Kingdom troops.
