I identified an ammonite (*Forbesiceras conlini*) which I couldn't get identified prior to receiving the Woodbine Paper. Thanks again.

Received your letter with check enclosed yesterday and appreciate same.

I'm sending a small box of fossils tomorrow. There are a few *Proceramus* from the Eagle Ford Formation which were collected near the vicinity of Dallas on the Trinity River.

There are three *exogyra* from the Navarro Fm. ~~collected from~~ These were collected in the 1930's when I was a boy. The location is listed in the *University of Texas Bulletin* # 4101 *Larger* *hr. Fossils of the Navarro group of Texas.* Six miles East of Castroville in Bexar County.

The other oyster is from the Eagle Ford (Arcadio Park).
