

TROPHIES FOR A.T.C. BOXERS

Sixteen trophies and cups have been given to the Air Training Corps Boxing Association by well-known people and leading aeronautical journals for the winners in the first all-Britain A.T.C. boxing championships on June 12, at the Royal Albert Hall.

In addition there is a "Blue Riband" Harewood trophy, presented by the Yorkshire A.T.C. Association to go to the A.T.C. command winning the highest points in the finals.

Some of the cups bear names well-known in commerce.

There is the "Selfridge" cup for feather weight juniors: the "Simon Marks" cup for junior bantams: the "Harry Price" cup for lightweight seniors: and the "Arthur Mack" trophy for senior middle weights.

"The Aeroplane" has given the fly weight junior cup: the "Flight" cup goes to the midget weight juniors: and "A.T.C. Gazette" cup to the light weight seniors.

JUNIOR:

Midget - "Flight" cup Mosquito - "Bertran Jones" cup; Bantam - "Simon Marks" cup; Fly weight - "Aeroplane" cup; Feather weight - "Selfridge" cup; Middle weight - "Bailey" cup; Light weight - "Eland" cup; Welterweight - "Chanier" cup.

SENIOR:

Flyweight - "Lawley" cup; Feather weight - "Duncan Smith" cup; Lightweight - "A.T.C. Gazette" cup; Middleweight - "Arthur Mack" trophy; Light heavyweight - "Harry Price" cup; Bantam - "Glendyne" cup; Welter - "Hilary" cup; Heavy weight - "Robert Strauss" trophy.

Runners up are to get medals presented by the Air League of the British Empire.
