Dear Mr. Deere:

I have done a good bit of checking and thinking over your letter of January 14, 1951. The idea of Mr. G. Bealmear's excellent and feasible. There is no doubt that such a project would help your engineers in interpreting their data.

You are probably aware that there is no publication within easy reach that treats these subjects. To reach your objectives you would have to use either one of two methods. (1) Cull the present literature for pertinent articles and have these either summarized or reproduced whole. (2) Have someone write several useful articles for the use of your company.

Both procedures would take a good deal of time and effort. You could probably gain a good estimate of what is available and what would have to be done if you were to go through the Bulletins of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists and check their contents for articles of the kind you would be interested in.

I believe if Mr. Bealmear or you could see me we could discuss this situation better than by writing letters. It seems to me that it is a larger project.

Are your engineers in a position to use the Bulletin of the A.A.P.G. for their information?
