The following Joint War Communique was issued from G.H.Q.
India, this morning:

Yesterday afternoon, December 10, a force of Japanese bombers escorted by fighters made a short attack on Chittagong.

The civil population calmly took shelter and although several bombs were dropped only a small amount of damage was caused. Casualties are reported to have been extremely light.

The enemy were intercepted by R.A.F. Hurricanes and many combats took place. Three of the raiders are confirmed as having been destroyed by our fighters and aircraft defences but full reports are not yet available.

Two of our fighters were shot down but the pilots are safe.
