Dear Dr. Stenzel,

I found your note when I returned from New York last night. This is a coincidence, because in the preparation of my work on Maestr., Danian and Montian I have read thru much of Hennig's papers in the Geol. Foren. Forhandl. He did much work on the Maestr.-Danian of Sweden but like so many others of his time believed the Danian fauna to be a transitional one, retaining a proponderance of Cretaceous forms and thus being of Cretaceous age.

Hope this translation is o.k. I have ~~had~~ tried to translate literally and then place in paranthesis where necessary a more accurate ^{or} ~~a~~ equivalent word. Let me know if there are any questions about various words. If you should use any place names or any Swedish words for that matter, ~~please~~ please check with me, as this is old Swedish, prior to the reform of 1905, in which the use of "ä", "ö" and "å" became more common and the abolition of the fv combination occurred.

Looking forward to seeing you in Denver. Al Fischer just stopped in and asks to be remembered.
