INDIA JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE NO. 118

The following Joint War Communique from India was received in London today:-

On the Arakan front there is no change in the general situation. Japanese efforts to penetrate our positions at several places have been vigorously repulsed.

Yesterday April 28 in close support of our ground forces R.A.F. bombers and fighters made a concentrated attack on enemy objectives along the Mayu ridge. Bursts were observed in the target area and the Japanese occupied village of Ngabyawchaungwya was set on fire. Another formation of Blenheims bombed Pinlebu in the Upper Chindwin area and demolished a number of buildings inside a fortified stockade.

All our aircraft returned safely.
