FOOD RATION BOOKS ARE NOT BURNT.

"Surrendered food ration books are treated as waste paper and pulp to help the National Effort", said an official of the G.P.O. in London to-day. He denied very emphatically the suggestion that such documents were destroyed by burning.

"Last July" the official continued "head Post Masters were instructed to begin issuing general clothing cards in exchange for out-of-date food ration books as from the middle of August. It was stated then that after certain checks had been applied to the used ration books, they should be disposed of for pulping."
