Despatch 119, covering period 6 p.m., March 21 to 6 p.m., March 22.

We had another quiet day on the Fifth Army Beachhead. There was no major move by either side. Our artillery, however, carried out some useful shoots, and there was the usual patrol activity.

The Luftwaffe raided the port area during the night, but the raid was a small affair by seven aircraft. We destroyed one.

German shells also caused casualties in one of our field hospitals in the early hours of this morning.
