INDIA JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE NO. 152

The following communique from G.H.Q., India was received in London this afternoon:-

Heavy rain has been falling in Arakan and there is no military activity to report.

Yesterday, June 1, R.A.F. Blenheims attacked Kalamyo and other enemy objectives in the vicinity. Bombs were seen to burst in the target areas but heavy cloud prevented detailed observation of results. In the afternoon Mohawk fighters bombed and machine gunned Japanese huts west of Kalamyo and silenced some anti-aircraft guns which opened fire on them.

Two of our aircraft are missing.
