S.R. 10 Supporting Proposed Admission Standards

WHEREAS, The University of Texas is seeking to maintain and improve its position among the first rank of centers of education and research, and

WHEREAS, It is the intention of the Student Senate and the Student's Association at large to support this goal, and,

WHEREAS, Recently the UT administration has announced its intention to ask the Board of Regents to approve a new admissions structure consisting of automatic admissions to those students who score above 1200 on the SAT or are in the top 10% of their high school class and a review procedure for all applicants not automatically accepted, and,

WHEREAS, President Cunningham has stated that this new policy will not weaken the university's commitment to the provisional admittance program or minority student recruitment, and,

WHEREAS, It is the opinion of the Sixth Student Senate that this new procedure, which simultaneously raises entrance requirements while allowing a review process to ensure that all qualified students may attend the university, now,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SIXTH STUDENT SENATE THAT; The Student's Association supports the proposed change in entrance procedure now before the UT Board of Regents and

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Student's Association supports this measure in conjunction with renewed efforts to boost the recruitment of minority students to the University of Texas.
