Thank you very much for your post card of July 5, and for remembering me when you found those Taff separates. If you can spare a copy, it would be appreciated. I am glad to note you have the information on the Glen Rose of Texas that you needed. Adkins did a good job summarizing the Cretaceous in the Univ. Texas Bull. 3232. His portion of the book is the best of the three, next comes Plummer's and the last is Sellards's, whose portion is not much used or quoted. Adkins always claimed the chief reason Sellards's book over the Paleozoic was that in that way he would be the first author in the book, although Plummer was really the Paleozoic expert at the Bureau at that time.

The manuscript on the history of stratigraphic exploration is temporarily set aside again. There are other papers being pushed now. I am waiting for a reply from Miss Rose Taff.
