A RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING THE ENDEAVORS OF THE TEXAS STUDENT EXCHANGE; PROVIDING ASSISTANCE WHERE POSSIBLE;

WHEREAS, the political turmoil in South Africa has is of major concern to the United States government and to concerned citizens throughout our nation, including students at this University; and

WHEREAS, despite the differing views on how best to approach the continuing oppression of Black South Africans, it can be generally agreed that South Africa is geographically and strategically important to the United States; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the United States, South Africa and all concerned parties to have in South Africa for any transition in political power educated Black leaders at all levels who have the necessary tools to effectively operate that nation's political and economic system; and

WHEREAS, the best way to provide for such leaders is to give promising Black students in that country solid educations in the best colleges and universities in the United States; and

WHEREAS, there exists the aptitudes and the interest in the United States government and private organizations in the United States and South Africa to make this feasible; and

WHEREAS, a newly established student organization endeavors to give young Black South Africans opportunities to attend this University through scholarships provided by a student-managed fund-raising drive; therefore

Be it Resolved by the Student Senate of the University of Texas:

that the Fifth Student Senate voices its support for the Texas Student Exchange in its efforts to bring international students, especially Black South Africans, to the University of Texas;

and further

Be it Resolved that the Students' Association provide assistance, not including lobbying and funding, to the Texas Student Exchange.
