Call to Order

Representative Fitzer said that he at the last meeting said that he wanted representation on the Board not money. **Representative N. Anderson** said that she wanted to review them first.

President's Report - Howard Nirken

Union \$300000 in debt. will raise fees if no Bookstore. money will go to new Union East or to other Union activities. We are the only large university without a bookstore. The bookstore would pay for all the renovations. **Representative Scheschuk** said that Bus Council had many problems with the idea because the Bookstore could raise the price of books after the other bookstores went out of Business. Howard said that the Coop would not go out of business. **Sean Mast** said that we pay more money on Union fees than on an athletic sticker. **Representative Hufford** said that the benefits of the bookstore can be seen, but we cannot see the benefits visually of the bookstore.

AB58 - Amended Appropriations Committee Bylaws Section F changed. Members of Appropriations committee will be elected by the SA every semester. This would allow stability on the committees. **Representative Mike Gray** said that they were careful and applied lots of thought to the bill. Call to question. Approved by Acclimation.

AB 59- Any questions. Motion to Debate. **Representative Murray** asked how someone would be appointed to the committee? **Fltzer** said that it was in the bylaws. Accepted by acclimation. Roll Call Vote. Yes 25, Abstain -2.

AB 60 - Sponsor add **Bethel McCoy**. Appropriations and Citizen's Affairs. Have gotten money from Vick, Dean of Students, etc. Lots of high schools involved. Kickoff party is with KA Psi. Motion to Debate. **Representative Murray** said that he was concerned about the amount of funds that this project was costing. **Marks** said that it would be a permanent project that should take the place of Round Up. **Murray** said that we should table the bill because we do not have the budget. Did not pass. Call to Question. It passed Yes 24 No 3

AB61 - IASSA Money went to keynote speakers. Motion to Debat Call to Question. Passed unanimously.

AB62 - Purpose of Ad Hoc committee. is to get long term plan. **Representative Gray** said that lots of people will be involved. It will be part of the UT libraries. There should be a vision of what the UT campus should look like. Call to Question. It passed Yes 21, No 4 Abstain 2.

AB63 - AIESEC Sponsors **Gray, Ehlers**. There was lots of people at the conference. Motion to debate. **Financial Directo Rosenstien** said that it is very hard to reimburse people. Students should pay for the conferences by themselves. Call to question. Yes 0, No 24, Abstain 2

AB64- was tabled by appropriations, because no rep was there. It needs to be heard. Motion to move to a committee as a whole. It failed. Tabled.
