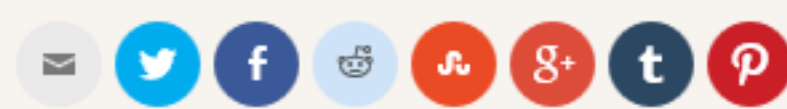
Stories from Summer Vacation: Superheroes in the Library with Andrew Friedenthal by American Studies

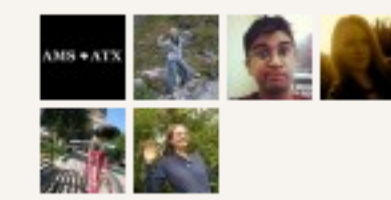
