In Support of Standardizing Class Enrollment Days

WHEREAS, Student Government serves as the official voice of students at the University of Texas at Austin; and,

WHEREAS, Add/drop begins the week day before the first day of class for all students at the University of Texas at Austin¹; and,

WHEREAS, All students have the first 4 days of class to add/drop classes²; and,

WHEREAS, After the 4th day of class students are required to get permission from the department of a class they wish to add³,

WHEREAS, All students are able to add classes until the 12th day of class with the permission of the specific department that the class falls under; however, some departments choose to not add students to their courses after the add/drop period and do not have to,

WHEREAS, The 12th day of class is the last day an undergraduate student may add a class except for rare and extenuating circumstances⁴,

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Student Government believes that all departments should enroll students into their desired classes in the case that there is room in the class and the student has received approval from the professor or instructor to join the class;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Student Government at the University of Texas at Austin hereby establishes a full 12 class day period for all students to enroll in their desired course regardless of the department as long as the class is not full and the professor or instructor grants the student permission via email or letter that a student can present to the department; and,
