INDIA JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE NO. 221

The following communique was received in London
from India this morning:

During yesterday, September 18, R.A.F. Beaufighters maintained their attacks on Japanese communications and installations in Burma.

Amongst a number of targets in the Prome area damaged with machine gun and cannon fire were two locomotives, five military lorries, twenty sampans and troops, barracks near Henzada, and beside the railway line from Prome to Letpadan.

Hurricanes were active over the Mayu peninsula, a number of attacks being made on enemy occupied villages south of Buthidaung.

From the day's operations none of our aircraft is missing.
