AB 22 To Change the Duties of the Communication Agency
A BILL TO BE ENTITLED An Act

To modify the Internal Rules of Procedure for The Student Government of The University of Texas at Austin:

Be it enacted by the Assembly of The Student Government of The University of Texas at Austin:

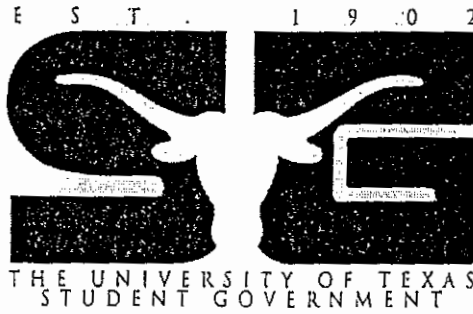
SECTION I: Amend the Internal Rules of Procedure for The Student Government of The University of Texas at Austin, Article XII, by removing the phrase "shall have one Director" and replace it with "shall have two Directors and one Assistant Director."

SECTION II: Amend the Internal Rules of Procedure for The Student Government of The University of Texas at Austin, Article XII, by adding this sentence to Section 4: "As the chief operating officer of this agency, the Communications Agency Director will also weekly correspond to the student newspaper in order to openly communicate the present proceedings of Student Government to the students of The University of Texas at Austin."

SECTION III: Amend the Internal Rules of Procedure for The Student Government of The University of Texas at Austin, Article XII, by deleting Section 7 that reads: "There shall be two Digital Communications Delegates to the Communication Agency appointed by the Communications Director. The Communications Agency will also define this position's role and duties."

SECTION IV: Amend the Internal Rules of Procedure for The Student Government of The University of Texas at Austin, Article XII, by deleting Section 8 that reads: "The Communication Agency shall supervise in the facilitation of a Student Government table for no less that three times a week excluding holidays."

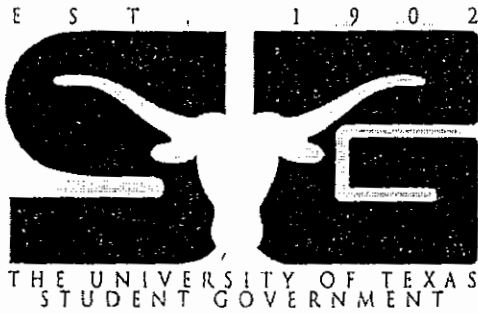
