Mr. President:

I have marked the key passages in Harriman's discussion with Maurer, on Vietnam. It comes to this:

-- Maurer believes a possibility for negotiations exists because the U.S. and Hanoi agree that "the South Vietnamese people should decide their own destiny"(see pp. 2-3);

-- He agreed to undertake an initiative based on this principle.
