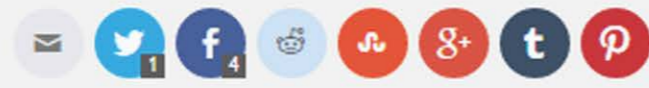
Faculty Research: Elizabeth Engelhardt and Randy Lewis Featured in Liberal Arts Video Series by American Studies
