Dear Dr. Aldrich:

I notice in Clark & Twitchell U.S.G.S. Monograph
LIV, page 126, that you have found an echinoid in
the lower Claiborne of Lee County, Texas. This
echinoid is named *Echinocystus texanus* Twitchell.
We are doing much work now with the echinoid of
the lower Claiborne of East Texas. For this reason,
I would like to know a little more about your find
in Lee County. Could you perhaps remember ap-
proximately at what place, or near what place, that
echinoid was found? In Lee County there are at
least two fossiliferous horizons and I would like
to be able to place the fossil exactly.

Any help you can give me in this matter will be
very much appreciated.
