
Dear Dr. Stenzel:

Dr. Muller has asked me to acknowledge and thank you for the shipment of Neitheas which he found waiting for him on his return from a trip. He had only time to unwrap and examine them hastily, as he is leaving immediately on another trip. He is, however, delighted at such variety and such fine quality of material, and he will put it to use as soon as he comes back, I am sure. He has the laboratory table loaded with Triassic Pectinidae which he has been busy studying this summer and evidently wishes to compare ~~it~~ with later Mesozoic forms.

In return for the Neitheas we shall send you before too long some California Eocene mollusks, including as many type species as we can, and type species of a number of Recent molluscan genera. I have the material partly selected already but will probably postpone packing it until I have finished putting the final touches on a new exhibit I am preparing for our entrance lobby, an illustrated geological time chart. This exhibit has taken most of my summer but I hope to get it installed within a week.
