A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS; NOW THEREFORE,

Be it enacted by the Student Assembly of the University of Texas that:

Section 1: Funds shall be appropriated from the multicultural projects fund in the following manner:

\$ 200

\$ 500

A. Jewish Student Council - \$800 for Chai Week

B. Asian Relations Committee - \$1000 for Asian American Student Orientation

Section 2: The money shall be used only on what is specified by the Appropriations Committee.

Section 3: All remaining funds from the groups specified above shall revert back to the Students' Association automatically two weeks after the date of the program, unless special arrangements are made with the Financial Director.
