JOINT ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE  
AND THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN  
IRELAND

Grassland Ploughing Grants.

The grant of £2 an acre, due to expire on 31st March, 1942, for the ploughing up of land that has been under grass for at least 7 years, is to be extended for another year. The extension does not affect a farmer's liability to comply with directions issued by a County War Agricultural Executive Committee to plough up within a certain time, and the farmer will not be entitled to be paid where he fails to comply with such a direction.

Similar arrangements are being made for the extension of the £2 per acre subsidy in Northern Ireland.
