Dear Sir:

A geologic map of the State of Texas showed two faults that I am very interested in. The first fault is located at the town of Singleton in Grimes County and extends in a north-east direction to the Grimes-Walker County line, intersecting that line about six miles north of the most westerly southwest corner of Walker County. The second fault begins about a mile north and slightly east of the eastern extremity of the first fault and extends in an easterly direction about six miles into Walker County. Both faults are shown to be down thrown to the north.

I have been unable to find any published data on these faults. I am more particularly interested in knowing the amount of throw. I would greatly appreciate any reference to published data you may be able to give me, or to any unpublished data you might have knowledge of. If you have any information that could be given me more easily by my coming to Austin rather than by correspondence, please advise me when it would suit your convenience to do so.
