A.B. 6 Special Committee on the Daily Texan

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

CREATING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE OF THE STUDENT ASSEMBLY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS TO ACQUIRE AND ORGANIZE INFORMATION REGARDING THE FINANCIAL CONDITION OF THE DAILY TEXAN, STUDENT NEWSPAPER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT AUSTIN; NOW THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by The Student Assembly of The University of Texas that:

SECTION I: A special committee of twelve shall be established to acquire and organize information regarding the financial condition of the Daily Texan.

SECTION II: Said committee shall be known as the Committee on the Daily Texan. (CDT)

SECTION III: The President of the Student Assembly shall appoint three members of the Committee from among the membership of the Student Assembly, said appointments subject to the approval of the Student Assembly.

SECTION IV: The President of the Students' Association shall appoint four members to the Committee from among the student body at large, including at least one graduate student, said appointments subject to the approval of the Student Assembly.

SECTION V: The Editor of the Daily Texan for the 1989-1990 year shall appoint five members to the Committee, said appointments shall not be subject to the approval of the Student Assembly.

SECTION VI: The duly appointed members of the committee shall elect a chairman from among themselves at their first regular meeting.

SECTION VII: All appointments subject to the approval of the Student Assembly shall be submitted to the Student Assembly for approval at the Student Assembly meeting immediately following passage of this bill.

SECTION VIII: The members of the committee shall, over the Summer Session, review information regarding financial condition of the Daily Texan and its facilities.

SECTION IX: The members of the Committee shall make themselves available to the Staff of the Daily Texan and Texas Student Publications so as to utilize those staffs' expertise on this issue, and shall work as closely as possible with said Staffs in the process of gaining information.

SECTION X: The Committee shall copy, assemble, and organize any particularly informative, illuminative, or useful information that they may discover in the course of their investigations.

SECTION XI: The Committee and the individual members thereof shall submit a report reflecting their findings and containing all relevant information (including any documents preserved pursuant to SEC. IX) to the Students' Association, The Daily Texan, and the Texas Student Publications on or before December 1, 1989.
