[1] One

The purpose of Democratic Education at Texas (DemTex) shall be to provide student-facilitated courses and promote egalitarian education at the University of Texas at Austin.

[2] Two

Any undergraduate, graduate student, faculty or staff member may join DemTex.

[3] Three

DemTex will be managed by a coordinating board composed of two (2) coordinating directors, two (2) community czars in charge of cultivating community in the organization, two (2) outreach and publicity directors in charge of informing students of DemTex opportunities, and one (1) treasurer to manage finances.

[4] Four

The Coordinating Board will fill board vacancies by a method of their choosing. Any student at the University is eligible for a board position. A term on the coordinating board is two semesters, and terms shall be staggered such that at least half the Coordinating Board members have prior Coordinating Board experience. Any unexpected coordinating board vacancies must be filled immediately by a replacement to serve the rest of the term. Coordinating Board members may be removed by a 2/3 vote of the Coordinating Board.

[5] Five

All members of the Coordinating Board shall be required to meet weekly at a day and time of the board's choice.
