Steven Bickerstaff was quoted in the *Houston Chronicle*, Nov. 9, 1999, regarding the requirements for a legal challenge to a bond election in which the Spanish translation on the ballot was allegedly incorrect. **Bickerstaff** was a participant in the annual Confederate Air Force conference on "Recollections of War," speaking on the legal restrictions imposed by international law on the use of force between sovereign nations.

Robert Dawson was quoted in *Texas Lawyer*, Nov. 8, 1999, on recent developments in Texas juvenile law.
