A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING MONIES FOR THE PURCHASE OF A **BUTTON MACHINE** TO BE
2 USED AS A FUNDRAISER : NOW , THEREFORE , BE IT ENACTED BY THE SIXTH
3 STUDENT SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS :

4 Section 1 . The Students' Association Budget for the Fiscal year
5 ending August 31, 1987, is amended by allocating the sum of two
6 hundred ninety-nine dollars and ninety-five cents (\$ 299.95) for the
7 purchase of a button maker machine for fundraising activities .

8 Section 2. Said funds will come from the Students' Association
9 Generated Funds line-item (680-A).

10 Section 3. The Fundraiser Director , under the Office of the
11 Financial Director, shall be responsible for the coordination of
12 this fundraiser project, expending necessary funds for the Students'
13 Association Fundraising Account (680-B) to ensure it's continuance .

14 Section 4. The Financial Director shall make the appropriate
15 expenditures upon passage of this bill .

GENERATED FUNDS
