
Dear Doctor Stenzel:

I have had a request recently for one of the lot of Gryphaeas which you borrowed in April, 1947. As at the time you indicated that you would be through with them by September, I wonder if it would inconvenience you to return the material? It comprises 47 specimens of 20 lots.

While we are on the subject of loans, I note that you are also signed out for four specimens of Ostreidae borrowed in March, 1946. These are Pycnodonte cochlear (1); Ostrea commercialis (1); and O. stentina (2). There is no immediate hurry for the return of the latter if you are still studying them; I mention it only as a matter of record.
